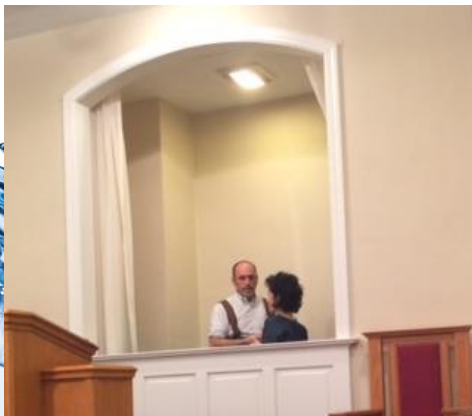
Taking the gospel to the local community and abroad. Mark 16:15

New sister in Christ Teresa Maurer being baptized by her brother Matt at North Main



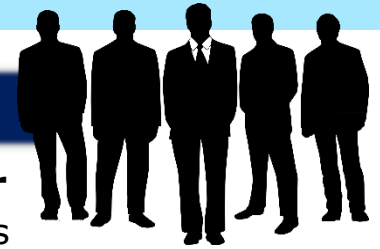
We are continuing our Just Christians Missions class on Monday nights. This time we are studying the book of James
